

ORDINANCE NO. 2

ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF STILLWATER FOR THE PURPOSE OF MAKING IT UNLAWFUL TO OPERATE OR MAINTAIN A PUBLIC GARBAGE OR RUBBISH DUMP OR DISPOSAL GROUNDS WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF STILLWATER, OR TO HAUL GARBAGE OR RUBBISH INTO THE TOWN OF STILLWATER FOR THE PURPOSE OF DUMPING OR DISPOSING OF IT WITHIN SAID TOWN.

SECTION I. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, or corporation to use any property, whether privately or publicly owned, within the Town of Stillwater for the purpose of ^{public} dumping or disposing of any garbage or rubbish, or for the owner of any property within the Town of Stillwater to permit or authorize the use of such property by the public for the dumping or disposal of any garbage or rubbish or for any person, firm or corporation to haul or bring garbage or rubbish into said town for the purpose of dumping or disposing of said garbage or rubbish upon any property within the Town of Stillwater.


SECTION II. The word "Garbage" as used herein shall include organic refuse resulting from the preparation of food, and decayed and spoiled food from any source. The word "Rubbish" as used herein shall include all inorganic refuse matter such as tin cans, glass, paper, ashes, sweepings, etc.

SECTION III. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and punished by a fine of not more than One hundred Dollars (\$100.00) or imprisonment of not more than ninety (90) days.

SECTION IV. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication according to law.
