

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING PUBLIC GARBAGE AND RUBBISH DUMPS AND DISPOSAL GROUNDS WITHIN THE TOWN OF STILLWATER, AND THE HAULING OF GARBAGE AND RUBBISH INTO SAID TOWN AND PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF.

The Board of Supervisors of the Town of Stillwater, Washington County, does ordain:

SECTION I. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to use any property, whether privately or publicly owned, within the Town of Stillwater for the purpose of public dumping or disposing of any garbage or rubbish, or for the owner of any property within the Town of Stillwater to permit or authorize the use of such property by the public for the dumping or disposal of any garbage or rubbish or for any person, firm or corporation to haul or bring garbage or rubbish into said town for the purpose of dumping or disposing of said garbage or rubbish upon any property within the Town of Stillwater except as hereinafter provided.

SECTION II. The word "Garbage" as used herein shall include organic refuse resulting from the preparation of food, and decayed and spoiled food from any source. The word "Rubbish" as used herein shall include all inorganic refuse matter such as tin cans, glass, paper, ashes, sweepings, etc.

SECTION III. Sanitary land fill permits may be granted and issued by the Town Board of Supervisors after a public hearing has been held in accordance with Ordinance No. 4, for public dumping of garbage and rubbish from time to time. The Town Board shall define the area where said dumping is to take place and attach such conditions and restrictions as they may require to said permit

No permit shall be granted for a longer period than one year. An annual fee shall be charged by the Town Board for issuance of said permit. The amount of said fee shall be determined by the Town Board from time to time.

SECTION IV. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and punished by a fine of not more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) or imprisonment of not more than ninety (90) days.

SECTION V. Ordinance No. 2 is hereby repealed.

SECTION VI. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication according to law.
