**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE COLLECTION REQUIREMENT OF
RECYCLABLE MATERIAL WITHIN THE SOLID WASTE COLLECTION AND
LICENSING COLLECTORS OF STILLWATER TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE NO. 111.**

THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF STILLWATER TOWNSHIP ORDAINS:

SECTION 1.0 Stillwater Township Ordinance No. 111, Section 6, (D) is amended as follows:

- D. Collecting Recyclable Material Required. It shall be the duty of each licensed mixed municipal solid waste collector to haul away on at least a bi-weekly basis to such places as designated in their license application the targeted recyclable materials from residences from which it hauls mixed municipal waste. The licensed mixed municipal solid waste hauler shall collect the targeted recyclable materials on the same day that the mixed municipal solid waste is collected. Nothing herein shall be construed to prevent a collector from offering residences recyclable collection of other recyclable materials.

SECTION 2.0 Effective Date. This ordinance shall be effective following its passage and publication by law.
