AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE NO. 43 PROVIDING
FOR LICENSEES' PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE

The Board of Supervisors of the Town of Stillwater ordains
as follows:


SECTION 1. Liability insurance. Ordinance No. 43,
Section 12, is amended to read:

SECTION 12. Liability Insurance. Any person holding
a license hereunder or working under state license shall
file with the Township Clerk policies of public liability
insurance which shall remain and be in force and
effect during the entire term of said license and which
shall contain a provision that it shall not be cancelled
without 10 days written notice to the Township. The
policy limits shall be as prescribed by the Town Board
of Supervisors by resolution from time to time, a copy
of which shall be kept on file at the office of the
Town Clerk, and open to public inspection at all reason-
able times. Said policies of insurance shall further
provide for indemnity and security to the Township of
Stillwater against any liability or responsibility for
the acts, actions, or omissions of the licensee or of
any of the agents or servants of such licensees subject
to the limitations as to amount herein stated. No
work shall be done under any license hereunder until
said insurance policies shall have been filed and ap-
proved by the Township Clerk.

SECTION 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be
effective upon publication.

Phil Easton, being duly sworn, on oath says he is and during all the times herein stated has been the Publisher and Printer of the newspaper known as Stillwater Evening Gazette and has full knowledge of the facts herein stated as follows: (1) Said newspaper is printed in the English language in newspaper format and in column and sheet form equivalent in printed space to at least 900 square inches. (2) Said newspaper is a daily and is distributed Monday through Friday of each week, except holidays. (3) Said newspaper has 25% of its news columns devoted to news of local interest to the community which it purports to serve and does not wholly duplicate any other publication and is not made up entirely of patents, plate matter and advertisements. (4) Said newspaper is circulated in and near the municipality which it purports to serve, has at least 500 copies regularly delivered to paying subscribers, has an average of at least 75% of its total circulation currently paid or no more than three months in arrears and has entry as second-class matter in its local post-office. (5) Said newspaper purports to serve the City of Stillwater and surrounding area in the County of Washington and it has its known office of issue in the City of Stillwater in said county, established and open during its regular business hours for the gathering of news, sale of advertisements and sale of subscriptions and maintained by the publisher or persons in his employ and subject to his direction and control during all such regular business hours at which said newspaper is printed. (6) Said newspaper files a copy of each issue immediately with the State Historical Society. (7) Said newspaper is made available at single or subscription prices to any person, corporation, partnership or other unincorporated association requesting the newspaper and making the applicable payment. (8) Said newspaper has complied with all the foregoing conditions for at least one year preceding the day or dates of publication mentioned below. (9) Said newspaper has filed with the Secretary of State of Minnesota prior to January 1, 1966 and each January 1 thereafter an affidavit in the form prescribed by the Secretary of State and signed by the Publisher and sworn to before a notary public stating that the newspaper is a legal newspaper.
