AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE NO. 66
CONCERNING INGRESS FROM AND EGRESS TO TOWN ROADS

THE TOWN BOARD OF STILLWATER TOWNSHIP, MINNESOTA ORDAINS:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 66 is hereby amended by adding Section 7 to read as follows:

Maintenance. The owner of a driveway intersecting with a town road shall be responsible for culvert maintenance and cleaning. If the owner fails to maintain and clean the culvert, the Township shall have the right, but not the obligation to do so, and assess the cost pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 429.101.

Section 2. Ordinance No. 66 is hereby amended by adding Section 8 to read as follows:

Driveway Blocking Drainage. If the Town Board determines that a driveway crossing a public ditch is obstructing drainage, the Town Board shall notify the landowner that the owner must remove the obstruction by installing a culvert. If the landowner fails to do so, the Town Board may cause the work to be done and assess the cost pursuant to Minn. Stat. Chapter 429.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its passage and publication.
